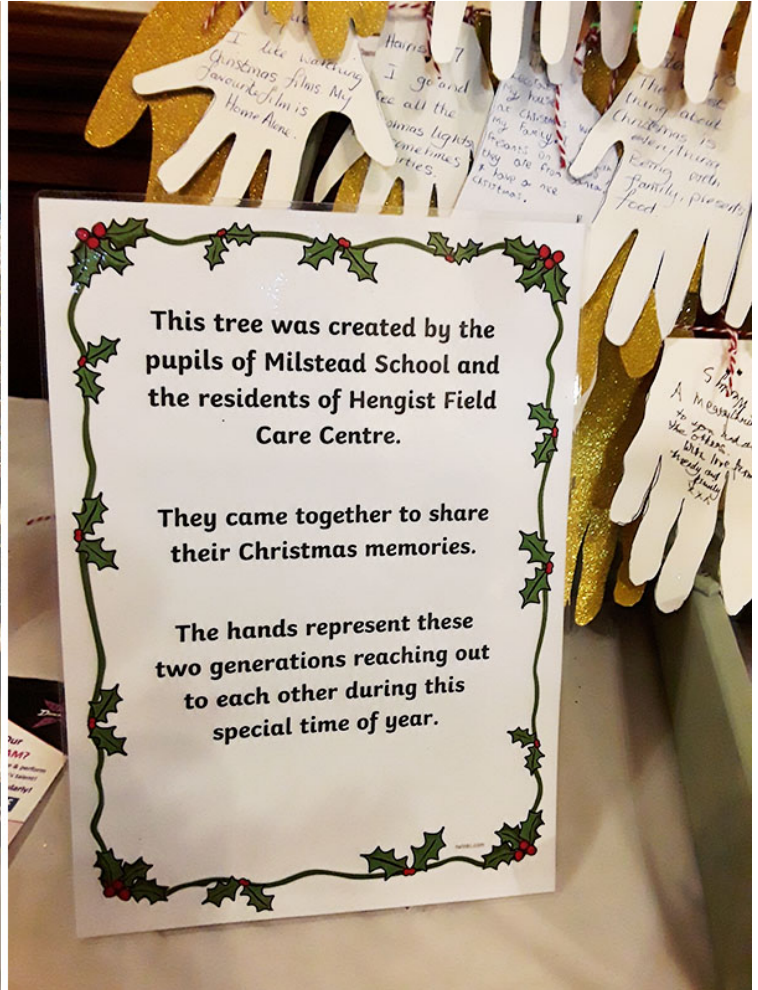


Hengist Field Care Home residents and local school children create handprint Christmas tree
