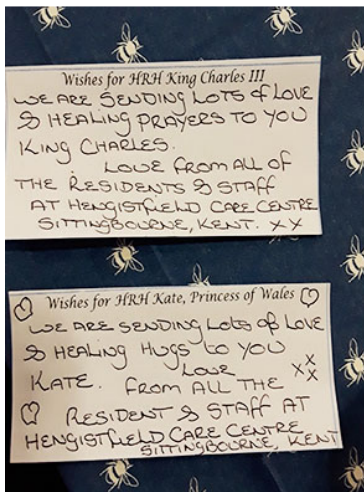
We listened to some **primary school children singing** and a **band consisting of older children**, plus some **wonderful dancing and more beautiful singing** from senior pupils.
